

Becoming a Guest Auditor at the University of Halle

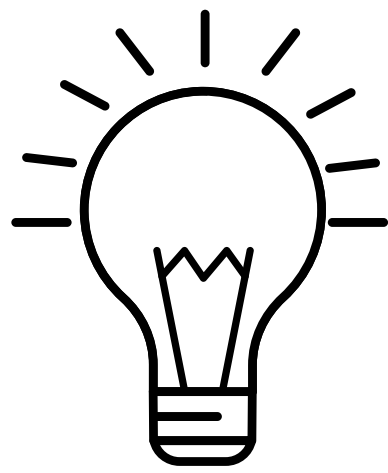

What is a guest auditor?

As a guest auditor you can attend **individual courses** offered by the faculties of the University of Halle.

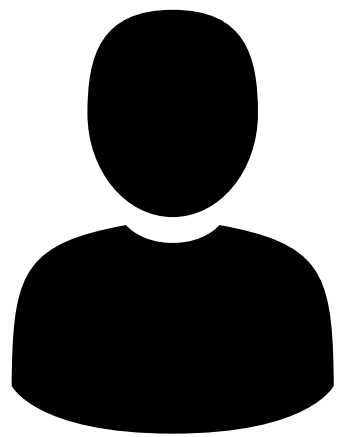
You can attend a maximum of 10 hours per week per semester.



What are the requirements for becoming a guest auditor?

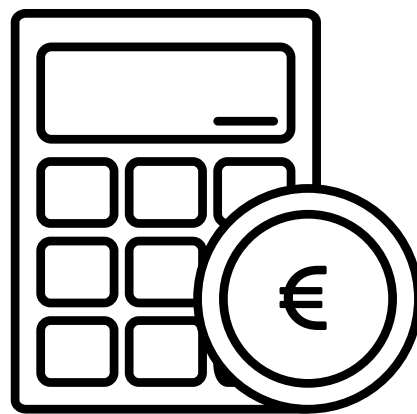
Adults of **all ages** can become guest auditors **regardless of their education and qualification level**.

However, simultaneous enrolment as a student and as a guest auditor is not possible.



What does it cost to become a guest auditor?

For refugees and all persons who receive state aid according to the Asylum Seekers Benefits Act, becoming a guest auditor is **free of charge**. (Proof required: Copy of the benefit certificate)



Which courses can I attend?

As a guest auditor, you can take part in individual courses offered by the faculties of the University of Halle.



The courses in question can be viewed online in the **course catalogue** for the respective semester. (almost all courses are in German!)

How do I become a guest auditor?

To become a guest auditor at the University of Halle, you must **apply for registration** for the coming semester.



For the summer semester (begins in April), the application must be submitted by **15 March**, for the winter semester (begins in October) by **15 September**.
